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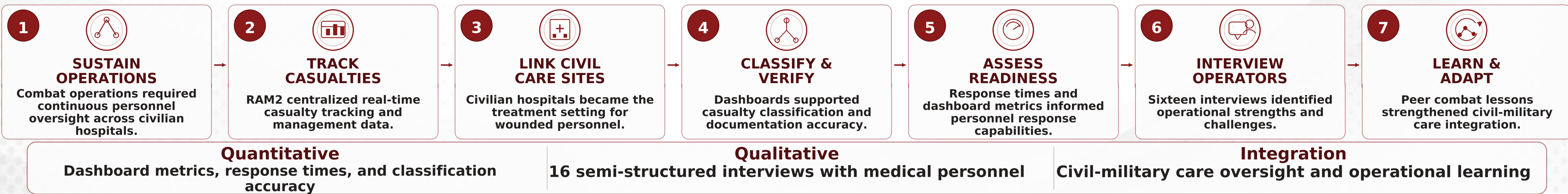
TAKE-HOME MESSAGE

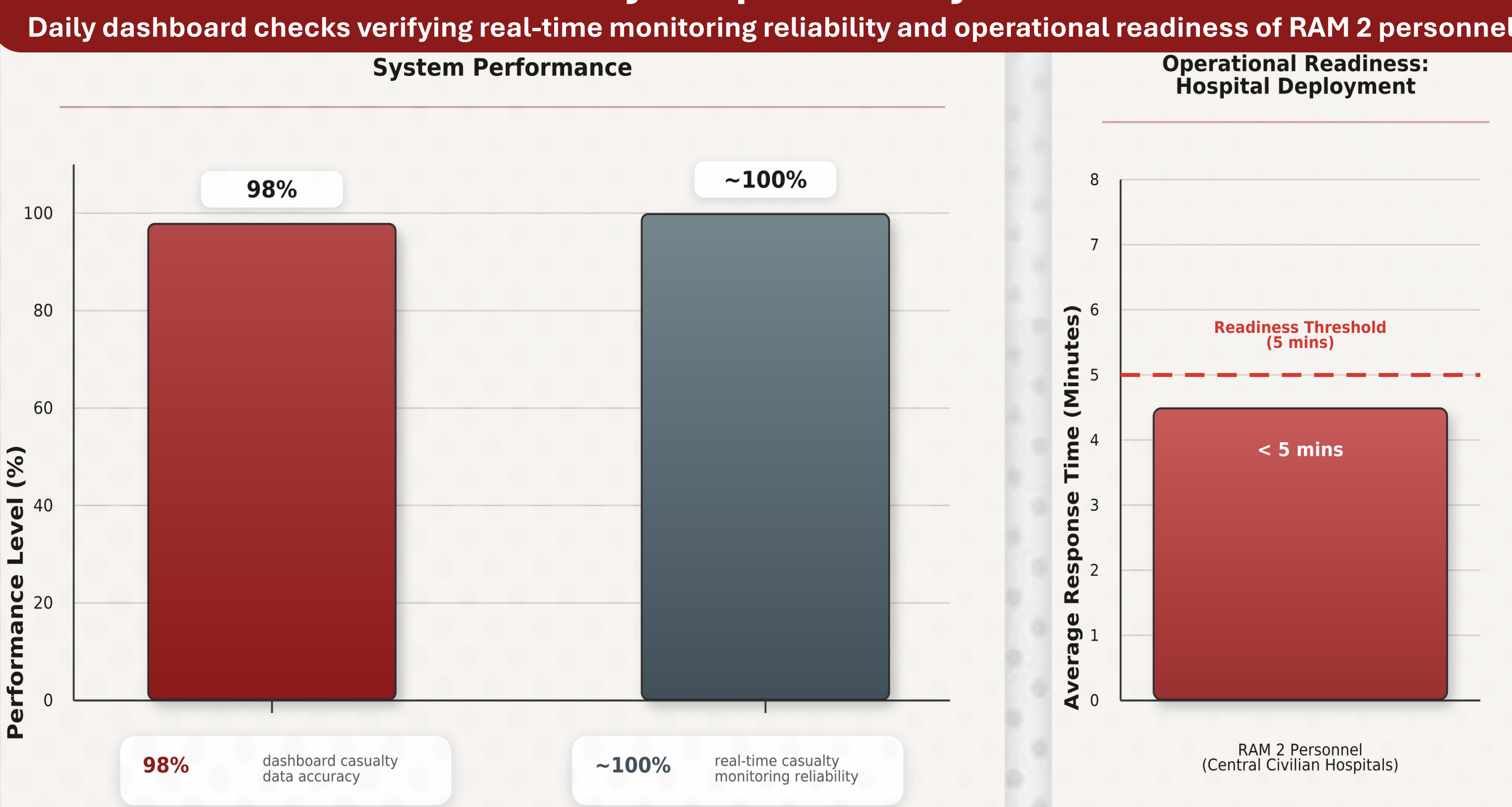
FROM RAM2 TRACKING TO CIVIL-MILITARY MEDICAL OVERSIGHT

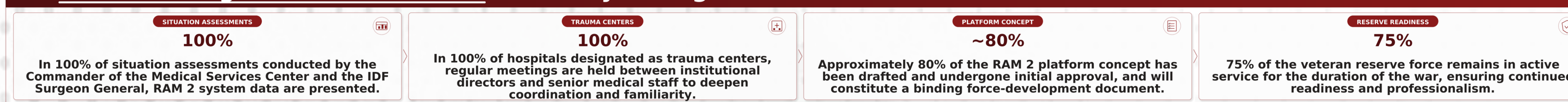
WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?
